



Mylan Park's COVID-19 Response Modified Operating Plan

As Mylan Park continues to closely monitor the Coronavirus situation, and in light of recent information and recommendations from the CDC and our local health organizations, Mylan Park will be taking elevated precautionary measures effective **Monday, March 16, 2020**. These measures will come in the form of a **Modified Operating Plan** aimed at reducing the number of potentially affected contact points among patrons and staff. The following limited access, reduced operating hours, program postponements, and facility closures are identified below and currently anticipated to remain in effect through **April 10, 2020**.

THE AQUATIC CENTER AT MYLAN PARK

Beginning Monday morning March 16, access to the Aquatic Center at Mylan Park will be limited to **Members only** in an effort to significantly reduce the number of users in an area at any given time. This measure will better allow for our patrons to practice the recommended social distancing and will provide our staff greater access and effectiveness as we enact our advanced cleaning protocols.

This means that the Aquatic Center will be **closed to all guests** including those who have previously purchased 1, 5, or 10 visit passes. Small group rentals such as Birthday Parties will continue as scheduled but no additional will be scheduled within this modified operating period.

In addition, we will observe **reduced operating hours** of as follows:

- Monday – Friday: 6 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Saturday: 7 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Sunday: 12 p.m. – 6 p.m.

LEARN TO SWIM & AQUATIC PROGRAMS

According to the CDC, there is no evidence that COVID-19 can be spread through the use of pools and hot tubs. However, due to the close physical interaction required, **all group and private Learn to Swim programs and Safety Trainings will be temporarily postponed. Aquatic Fitness and Water Aerobics will continue as scheduled** but will be structured to limit personal contact and eliminate shared use of equipment.

Other areas of the park operations will be modified as follows:

- Anker Fields Complex – Closed
- Hazel & J.W. Ruby Community Center – Closed
- Lower Park Pavilion – Limited use, small group sizes
- Track & Field Complex – Limited use, small group sizes
- Turf Athletic Fields – Limited use, small group sizes
- Monongalia County Extension Services and 4-H Center – Limited use, small group sizes
